## Uniform

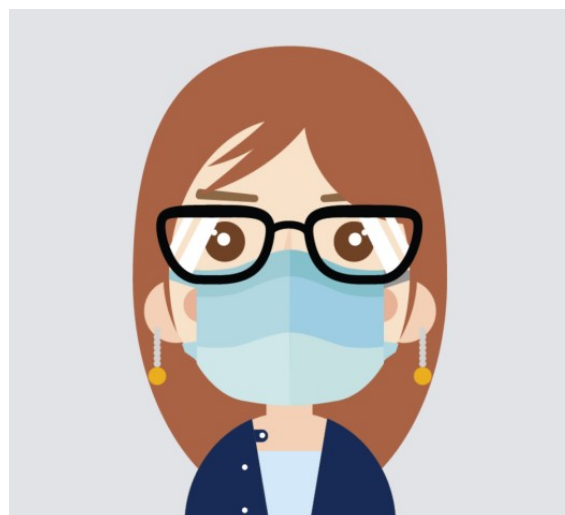
- Raspberry sweatshirt - available at [www.superstitch86.co.uk](http://www.superstitch86.co.uk)
