Year 1 held a Royal Tea Party on Thursday with some special visitors!

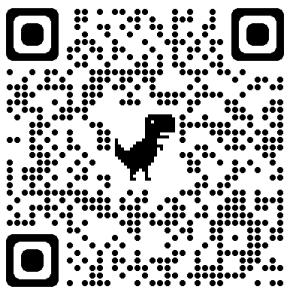
