The Prefects work hard each day in and out of class showing how to be respectful and polite to the younger year groups.

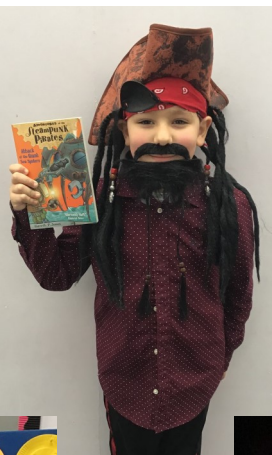
